English Speaking Countries

- **225 million** Americans speak English as a first language and **43 million** Americans speak it as a second language.
- **375 million** people speak English around the world.
- There are more than **50** English speaking countries.
- English is the third most common primary language in the world (behind Mandarin Chinese and Spanish).
- In the mid-20th century, nearly **9 percent** of the world's population grew up speaking English as their first language. In 2050, the number is expected to be **5 percent**.
